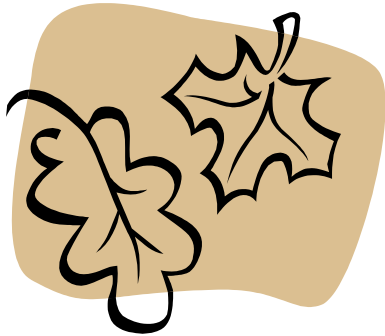


Library Corner March 2009
